*Exceptional complexity, balance and elegance, with powerful tannins and aromas of very ripe fruit accentuated by spicy notes of cedar, laurel and eucalyptus*

### Vina Cobos Bramare Malbec

Argentina, Mendoza, Lujan de Cuyo 2013 **AD22 21/90**

*The nose has great presence of cassis and strawberry opening to joyful notes of caramel, white pepper, star anise, dark chocolate and graphite, enlivened with delicate mint and rosemary notes.*

**Saint Cosme Côte-Rôtie Syrah** France,  
Northern Rhône Valley, Côte-Rôtie 2014 **AA15 28/125**  
*The 2014 has filled out during the ageing phase and such a fusion of classicism and pleasure can only be a cause for delight. Soot, smoked bacon, violet graphite, cold ash, antique rose, and licorice.*

## **Château Grand Mayne Grand Cru** *Red Bordeaux Blend*

Saint-Émilion 2010 **AE18 42/195**

*Silky, plush, concentrated and showing a lot of depth, this wine has lush, polished curves for tannins, a wealth of sensuous ripe berries and licorice and a splash of liqueur in the finish. From 75% Merlot, 20% Cabernet Franc and 5% Cabernet Sauvignon.*

## **Bodegas Volver Triga Monastrell** Spain, Valencia, Alicante 2012 **AL14 16/65**

*Explosive aromas of black and blue fruits are transformed into notes of licorice, Indian spices, and floral oils. Rich and long, it has good acidity that gives it elegance. In the mouth, sweet cranberries and gooseberries tint the palate with persistence in a spicy and concentrated finish.*

## **Château Vignot Grand Cru Red Bordeaux Blend** France, Bordeaux, Saint-Émilion 2009 **Z28 22/95**

*With a hint of toast on the nose, the classic aromas (leather, cherry, and brandy) are melded with notes of cedar and coconut. The mouth feel is soft and round, with ripe, fine-grained tannins. It expresses elegance with a long finish.*

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## Medium to Full Bodied Reds



### Alto Moncayo Aquilon Garnacha

Spain, Campo de Borja 2012 **V8 38/175**

*Sleek and dense, it shows impressive richness yet remains focused and harmonious. Ripe black cherry and blueberry are balanced by savory notes of mineral and wild herbs. Firm tannins are well-integrated while a beam of acidity keeps it fresh.*

### Altesino Brunello di Montalcino Sangiovese

Italy, Montalcino 2011 **J22 23/100**

*From the Northeastern zone of the Montalcino hills a wine of hematic aromas, mixed with the delicateness of fresh flowers, such as rose and germanium. A taste of red fruit, a lot of cherry and accompanied by graphite, and sweet spices. The tannins are sensed but not excessive.*

### Pulenta Estate XI Gran Cabernet Franc

Argentina, Mendoza 2011 **N8 21/90**

*Deep ruby in color, with an intense aroma of roasted pepper, eucalyptus and spice. Its entrance on the palate is sweet and smooth. The wine is aged in new French oak barrels for 18 months, giving the wine an elegant and long finish.*

### Basilica Solatio Chianti Classico Sangiovese

Italy, Tuscany, Chianti Classico 2010 **N22 21/90**

*Rich and full of sweet cherry, plum, strawberry, tobacco and mineral flavors, this chianti classico is well structured and long. Shows fine balance and a finish that features iron, savory, and tobacco elements.*

### **Emma Zuccardi Bonarda 21/90**

Argentina, Mendoza 2013 **M22**

*Quite dark colored, it has earthy aromas and a clear Bonarda rusticity (tree bark). What is different here is the electric freshness in the palate. With a little bit of time it even develops flowery aromas and turns a lot more elegant.*

### **Siduri Clos Pepe Pinot Noir**

California, Santa Barbara, Santa Rita Hills 2014 **L22 23/100**

*Exotically perfumed scents of raspberry liqueur, cherry-cola, licorice, and oak spices. Pliant, spice-tinged red and dark berry flavors gain energy with air, taking a turn to zestier red fruits. Finishes with excellent thrust, silky tannins, and lingering spiciness.*

### **Les Champans Volnay Premier Cru Pinot Noir**

France, Burgundy, Côte de Beaune, Volnay 2011 **I16 31/140**

*Aromatic complexity with a broad-ranging nose of smoked tea, warm earth, underbrush, and a touch of wet stone on the mélange of perfumed red berry fruit. Intense and vibrant medium weight flavors that are shaped by phenolically mature and firm tannins.*

### **Urban Provence Grenache Noir Rosé Blend**

France, Côte de Provence 2017 **C9 50**

*Fresh, youthful, and full of wild strawberries and white pepper, this juicy, well structured wine finishes with minerality and a slight spice. A blend of Grenache Noir, Cinsault, Syrah, and Rolle, this slightly effervescent rosé is the most unique you have ever had.*

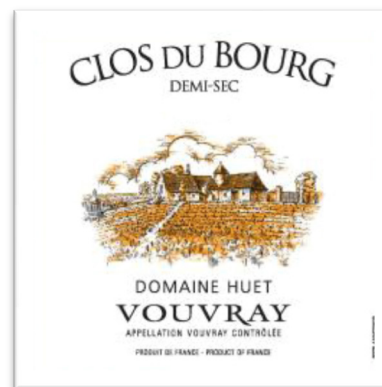

Loire Valley, Sancerre 2006 **G1 18/85**

*Soft attack, nicely rounded with lots of richness, yet still very fresh. Notes of fruit dominate (apricot, yellow peach). Harmonious on the palate with excellent length.*

**St Urbans-hof Bockstein Auslese Riesling**  
Germany, Mosel, Ockfen 2015 **E11 21/90**

*A fine spicy nose with a touch of flowery air and botrytis spices. On the palate, an opulent, yet racy fruit. Very fine with a long lasting finish.*



**Domaine Huet Clos du Bourg Vouvray Chenin Blanc**

France, Loire Valley, Vouvray 2014 **F16 19/80**  
*Intensely yellow in color, this vintage offers a very clear intense and aromatic bouquet of ripe yellow fruits along with crushed stone flavors. The attack on the palate is lovely, round and fruit-intense, but also has a very minerally and firmly structured finish*
