*A bouquet of deep blueberry, rich plum, and coffee, closely followed by chocolate and lustrous licorice spice with creamy vanilla constantly weaving its way through.*

Inspired by the wines first made by the Italian immigrants who originally settled in Napa Valley. The Prisoner is now the most recognized red blend, leading the resurgence of interesting blends by incorporating Zinfandel with the unlikely mix of Cabernet Sauvignon, Petite Sirah, Syrah, and Charbono. Bright aromas of ripe raspberry, vanilla, and coconut give way to flavors of fresh and dried blackberry, pomegranate, and vanilla, which linger harmoniously for a smooth and luscious finish.

The 2017 displays deep ruby color with enticing aromas of gingerbread, blackberry, and white pepper. The palate offers ample freshness, sweet tannins marked by hints of charred wood and mocha. It's nevertheless rich and ripe, with a long finish.

Silky, plush, concentrated and showing a lot of depth, this wine has lush, polished curves for tannins, a wealth of sensuous ripe berries and licorice and a splash of liqueur in the finish. From 75% Merlot, 20% Cabernet Franc and 5% Cabernet Sauvignon.

**Bodegas Volver Triga** *Monastrell* Spain,

Valencia, Alicante 2017 **AL11 65**

Explosive aromas of black and blue fruits are transformed into notes of licorice, Indian spices, and floral oils. Rich and long, it has good acidity that gives it elegance. In the mouth, sweet cranberries and gooseberries tint the palate with persistence in a spicy and concentrated finish.

## LOCAL DELAWARE WINE DRAFT

As a family farm winery, family comes first. The Nunan family is headed by Chuck and Chris. Their first (very successful) joint venture began in 1974 when they got married. Their three sons, Chip, Christopher, and Craig are all nearby and work in the family businesses. All three boys are married and there are currently nine grandchildren and one great-grandson. This family theme is evident in the Harvest Ridge logo. The roots of the Harvest Ridge tree are prominent, in part, to reflect the deep roots and lineage of the Nunan family.

Further to the theme of the logo is the number 47. Representative of the 47th mile marker on the MASDIX Tangent line from the 1765 Survey is a dressed Portland Stone shaft set by surveyors Mason and Dixon in 1765 to demarcate the boundary between Delaware and Maryland.

### **Alto Moncayo Aquilon Garnacha**

Spain, Campo de Borja 2016 **Z5 175**

*Sleek and dense, it shows impressive richness yet remains focused and harmonious. Ripe black cherry and blueberry are balanced by savory notes of mineral and wild herbs.*

*Firm tannins are well-integrated while a beam of acidity keeps it fresh.*

### **Altesino Brunello di Montalcino Sangiovese**

Italy, Montalcino 2014 **J6 139**

*From the Northeastern zone of the Montalcino hills a wine of hematic aromas, mixed with the delicateness of fresh flowers, such as rose and germanium. A taste of red fruit, a lot of cherry and accompanied by graphite, and sweet spices. The tannins are sensed but not excessive.*

### **Pulenta Estate XI Gran Cabernet Franc**

Argentina, Mendoza 2015 **TEMP UNAVL 90**

*Deep ruby in color, with an intense aroma of roasted pepper, eucalyptus and spice. Its entrance on the palate is sweet and smooth. The wine is aged in new French oak barrels for 18 months, giving the wine an elegant and long finish.*

Quite dark colored, it has earthy aromas and a clear Bonarda rusticity (tree bark). What is different here is the electric freshness in the palate. With a little bit of time it even develops flowery aromas and turns a lot more elegant.

Aromatic complexity with a broad-ranging nose of smoked tea, warm earth, underbrush, and a touch of wet stone on the mélange of perfumed red berry fruit. Intense and vibrant medium weight flavors that are shaped by mature and firm tannins.

### Urban Provence Grenache Noir Rosé Blend

France, Côte de Provence 2017 **50 TEMP UNAVL**

Fresh, youthful, and full of wild strawberries and white pepper, this juicy, well structured wine finishes with minerality and a slight spice. A blend of Grenache Noir, Cinsault, Syrah, and Rolle, this slightly effervescent rosé is the most unique you have ever had.

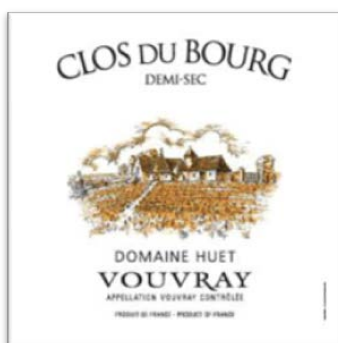

*Intensely yellow in color, this vintage offers a very clear intense and aromatic bouquet of ripe yellow fruits along with crushed stone flavors. The attack on the palate is lovely, round and fruit-intense, but also has a very minerally and firmly structured finish*

*Soft attack, nicely rounded with lots of richness, yet still very fresh. Notes of fruit dominate (apricot, yellow peach). Harmonious on the palate with excellent length.*

*A fine spicy nose with a touch of flowery air and botrytis spices. On the palate, an opulent, yet racy fruit. Very fine with a long lasting finish.*
